


Child Assessments/VPK Assessments

SR Terminations

- Please terminate SR enrollments the same day they are no longer attending your facility.
- If a child is still showing up on your roster for a date that has already been processed, you need to terminate them the first day of the current month.
 - i.e. Last day 8/17/2021 but they are still showing up, you would mark last day of attendance as 2/1/2022 because January has already been processed.
 - Please do this for all children who are no longer enrolled with you to "clean up" your attendance.
 - Moving forward be sure to terminate them the same day.

Emergent Literacy Requirements

- All VPK <u>lead</u> instructors, including those holding a valid Florida educator certificate, must complete three 5-hour emergent literacy courses, an increase from the previous requirement of one emergent literacy course. After completing the first three emergent literacy courses, VPK <u>lead</u> instructors must complete one emergent literacy course every five years. Must be completed by 7/1/22
- Most of the 5-hour emergent literacy courses contain 3 parts:
 - 1. 3 hour instructor led training online
 - 2. 1 hour "homework" using techniques in your classroom
 - 3. 1 hour meeting/discussion with reginal facilitator
- This could take up to a month to complete, please don't wait




VPK Director Endorsement

- In the past, there have been categories of VPK directors who did not have to be endorsed.
- These included those who received their Director's Credential before 2006, and many who worked in public and private schools (such as principals).
- Now, the only exception to the VPK Director Endorsement is Private and Public-School Administrators with a valid teaching certificate and valid (not expired) Educational Leadership on the certificate.
- All other VPK directors must take classes, including both Level 1 and Level 2 directors

VPK Director Endorsement

- All certified directors must take the classes listed below on the DCF website to become VPK Director Endorsed:
- Implementing the Florida Standards in Preschool Classroom: 3 Years Old to Kindergarten (on or after 7/1/2018) - 5 Hour Online Course or 3 Hour Instructor-Led Course
- Emergent Literacy for VPK Instructors (DOE course) 5 Hour Online Course
- VPK Director Credential (DOE course) 5 Hour Online Course
- Mathematical Thinking for Early Learners (DOE course) 5 Hour Online Course
- Language and Vocabulary in the VPK Classroom (DOE course) 5 Hour Online Course

BSA - Base Student Allocation School Year Program Senate - Senate Appropriations Subcommittee on Education


VPK Base Rate Proposed Increase

- This funding would potentially increase the base student allocation from its current level of \$2,486 to \$3,294 starting in the 2022-23 school year. This would represent the largest increase in the program's history.
- This is an increase of \$808 per student per VPK year
- The Senate's proposal will help to lift all VPK teachers to at least \$15/hour.
- If approved, this will be the largest increase in the history of Florida's VPK program.




- Profiles need to be updated by 2.11.2022

 - 5. Check for correspondence from your ECS












