01. Welcome	Michele Kina	Meeting began at 9:10 with welcome by Michele King

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02. Approve: Meeting Minutes for October 27, 2023	Michele King	Michele King made motion to approve October 27, 2023, meeting minutes and Jamie Slack seconded motion. None opposed motion carried.
03. Quality and Grant Updates	Leona Adkins	Leona introduced the different grants that are now available to providers through ARPA Discretionary funding. Informed group that all providers have the opportunity to have Procare software installed at their centers for 3 years paid for by grant funding with no cost to the providers. Provided information on how Procare will allow ELC to pull attendance and streamline reimbursement process. Spoke on other items that would be provided to providers at no cost such as Kindergarten Readiness Kits, Laptops with software through MarcoPolo, Behavioral kits through Discovery Source. Grants available for Infant/Toddler classroom expansion and provider mini grants for their centers. Questions reading annual renewal, cost of services if center currently has ProCare were asked. All providers are encouraged to take advantage of current grants as there is no guarantee of any additional funding after funds are spent.
04 . Enrollments and Waitlist; Program Services updates	Gilda Duran	Cora Rice provided statistics of VPK and SR enrollments for all counties. SR enrollments 4890 as of 12.31.23. Lee 3633 Hendry 378, Glades 15, and Collier 1224. SR has a normal decline in November and December resulting from the school closures and holiday breaks. Families generally hold off on enrollment until after the new year. VPK applications open enrollment went live on 1.4.24, within 48 hours 464 applications were submitted. As of 1.12.204 1000 + VPK applications have been submitted. ELC VPK campaign has is showing great success with the increased applications. Staff are working applications on a first come basis. We had over 427 lobby walk in and over 2,902.00 phones call in the month of January thus far.
05 . Health & Safety updates and concerns	Danna Breeden	Reported an uptick in influenza, RSV, COVID, Chicken pocks and shingles. Many centers have had to establish clean rooms for children who are not sick. Blood pathogen training will be done at the next nurses town hall in February. You can earn CEU's by attending.

Danna Breeden will be conducting Bloodborne Pathogens training at the next Nurses Town Hall on the second Tuesday in February at 1:30 p.m. Providers in attendance can receive CEU credits. Due to low attendance during the day an evening meeting will be added. Providers will need to add their name to the chat for attendance. 2024-2025 profiles are now available to providers. Submission has begun. Many of the children have received their first Literacy Buddy book, and the second book is due by February 16, 2024.
		Humana sponsored a book drive for Literacy Buddy and donated over 300 books covering three locations. Every child who attended received a book. They also donated additional books to the classroom libraries.
