### ASQ's

- Ages and Stages Screenings
  - ALL SR children from birth to 60-months (5 years) must be screened in the first 45 calendar days of enrollment and yearly upon family redetermination.
  - All SR children does include children who are part-time, coming to you only half days or after school.
  - If the child is on your list, YOU are responsible to screen them.
  - If needed, print and send the questionnaire home, but you are still responsible to get it in the portal.
  - Non-Compliances are being sent out for late screenings.



#### VPK FAST

- All VPK children must be assessed through the VPK FAST Star Early Literacy program.
- Make sure you are using the NEW Renaissance URL, <a href="https://global-zone05.renaissance-go.com/welcomeportal/7957988">https://global-zone05.renaissance-go.com/welcomeportal/7957988</a>
- Administrator Usernames are your school email.
- Use "Forgot Password" to reset your password at any time.
- At least one person on site at each center must have the current Ren-U training. This must be done every year now. The course needed is, "VPK Test Administrators Getting Started with FAST Star Early Literacy Assessment."

#### VPK FAST Administration Schedule

- School Year or programs that have 83 or more instructional days:
  - PM1 The first 30 Instructional Days
  - PM2 at least 40% of hours have been completed and no more than 60% have been completed
  - PM3 The last 30 Instructional Days of VPK
- Summer or programs that have 82 or fewer instructional days:
  - PM1 The first 10 Instructional Days
  - PM2 At least 40% of hours have been completed and no more than 60% have been completed
  - PM3 The Last 10 Days of VPK
