## **Emergent Literacy Requirements**

All VPK <u>lead</u> instructors, including those holding a valid Florida educator certificate, must complete three 5-hour emergent literacy courses, an increase from the previous requirement of one emergent literacy course. After completing the first three emergent literacy courses, VPK <u>lead</u> instructors must complete one emergent literacy course every five years. Must be completed by 7/1/22

This could take up to a month to complete, please don't wait



### **VPK Director Endorsement**

All certified directors must take the classes listed below on the DCF website to become VPK Director Endorsed:

Implementing the Florida Standards in Preschool Classroom: 3 Years Old to Kindergarten (on or after 7/1/2018) - 5 Hour Online Course or 3 Hour Instructor-Led Course

Emergent Literacy for VPK Instructors (DOE course) - 5 Hour Online Course

VPK Director Credential (DOE course) - 5 Hour Online Course

Mathematical Thinking for Early Learners (DOE course) - 5 Hour Online Course

Language and Vocabulary in the VPK Classroom (DOE course) - 5 Hour Online Course
