ELC Report – state and local updates: Susan Block	<ul> <li>The legislative session is over.</li> <li>The legislative budget includes an additional \$25 million for school readiness.</li> <li>Funding for VPK remains at the same level</li> <li>Possibilities of a Quality Rating Improvement System for the state is supported by the Office of Early Learning (OEL)</li> <li>HB7069, if not vetoed, will give support for efforts to align assessment in early childhood programs. Section 27 provides for a Committee on Early Childhood Development. ELC of SWFL is requesting representation on the committee by board member Ashley Houk. The Committee would be staffed by the Lastinger Center.</li> <li>Florida OEL Fact Book data shows a lower percentage of VPK children this year. The group discussed possible reasons for this.</li> <li>Assessments – oral language is not addressed on the new Star assessment, yet this is the highest area on VPK assessment.</li> </ul>	http://www.floridaearlylearning.com /oel_resources/fact_book.aspx
Ashley Houk – OEL Response Letter	<ul> <li>The ELC board sent a letter to Department of Education Commissioner Pam Stewart and OEL Executive Director Rodney MacKinnon regarding the Star System assessment. A reply was received that stated OEL is looking at how to use VPK Assessment with the Star System to create the Readiness Rate.</li> <li>It is hoped that with HB7069 and the committee mentioned above, that there will be consideration of the appropriate use of tools to create the readiness rate.</li> <li>Ashley will prepare a response to the letter for review at the ELC board meeting in June.</li> </ul>	

Child Care Nutrition – JoAnne Fuciu	<ul> <li>Lee Health developed a program to help fight childhood obesity.</li> <li>They aligned their practice with the 5210 program – 5 fruits and vegetables, 2 hours of screen time, 1 hours of exercise or physical activity, 0 sugary drinks.</li> <li>Families and children were engaged in healthy menus and eating practices; introduced to new vegetables, fruits, and vegetarian foods.</li> <li>Weekly children were introduced new foods, recipes and at home activities</li> <li>Goal: Learning good lifestyle habits at a young age will establish healthy behaviors for a lifetime.</li> </ul>	
Health, Safety and Developmental Services – Patty Hansen	<ul> <li>Ms. Hansen offered 52 trainings this year in Collier, Glades, Hendry and Lee Counties. She has already submitted the trainings for next year, which will be on the ELC training site soon.</li> <li>May is water safety month. Ms. Hansen offered materials on water safety - downing is 100% preventable.</li> <li>Shallow water blackout was explained, in which the swimmer faints for lack of oxygen as a result of breath holding.</li> <li>Ms. Hansen is off for the summer; she will be back on Sept. 11.
