Presentation by Early Learning Coalition Staff	 Ms. Thompson presented an overview of the decision making process of the ELC to terminate the School Readiness Contract for Royal Crown Academy. The members of the committee asked clarifying questions of the ELC Staff. 	
Presentation of Appeal by Royal Crown Academy	Ms. Jamie Thomas was not present to speak for the Royal Crown Academy.	
Conclusion of Appeal Hearing	 Members of the staff were told that the committee would be deliberating. According to Sunshine Law, they are permitted to remain in the room while the committee deliberates. All remained in attendance while the committee deliberated. The committee members deliberated and came to a determination. 	Motion to uphold the decision by the ELC of SWFL to terminate the School Readiness Contract by Damaris Boone. Second by Jennifer Lange. Motion approved. The committee drafted minutes. Motion to approve the minutes by Jennifer Lange; Second by Damaris Boone. Motion approved. The original draft was signed by all three members of the committee.
Committee Decision	The Committee upheld the ELC decision to terminate for five years. The Committee cited this rationale for its decision: 1.
