

Capacity Requirements/Staff-To-Child Ratios by Facility Type

Family Day Care Home – includes one of the following groups, including children under 13 years old related to the operator:

- 4 children birth to 12 months; or
- 3 children birth to 12 months and other children for a total maximum of 6 children; or
- 6 preschool age children if all are older than 12 months; or
- 10 children if no more than 5 are preschool age and, of those five, no more than 2 are under 12 months.

Large Family Child Care Home – includes one of the following groups, including children under 13 years old related to the caregiver:

- A maximum of 8 children age birth to 24 months.
- A maximum of 12 children, no more than 4 children under 24 months.

Child Care Facility

- 1:4 Infants
- 1:6 One year old
- 1:11 Two year old
- 1:15 Three year old
- 1:20 Four year old
- 1:25 Five year old
- In groups of mixed age ranges, where children under one year of age are included, one staff member shall be responsible for no more than four children of any age group, at all times
- In groups of mixed age ranges, where children one year of age but under two years of age are included, one staff member shall be responsible for no more than six children of any age group, at all times
