



ACCOMPLISHMENTS



The Early Learning Coalition of Southwest Florida is one of 30 coalitions in Florida responsible for the administration of the School Readiness and Voluntary Prekindergarten programs. We serve Lee, Hendry, Glades and Collier counties. Here is our success story - by the numbers:

School Readiness - Child Care Services: Placing Children in Early Learning Programs **6,536** children received services at **348** different early learning programs in any given month. This enabled families to work and/or to go to school.



School Readiness - Child Care Resource & Referral: Helping Families Find Early Learning Programs

We received 11,357 requests for child care information from families regarding School Readiness, Voluntary Prekindergarten and child care services.


School Readiness - Quality Program Services: Helping Early Learning Programs to Grow **1,049** early learning professionals attended development programs through the coalition--earning **242** hours of continuing education credits.

We support programs using **Teaching Strategies Gold** to assess the developmental progress of children. We help early learning programs become knowledgeable about how to assess children and use the assessment data to be better teachers.


- **49** mentoring and coaching visits to early learning programs
- **21** office-based training programs for technical assistance
- **2,284** technical assistance calls by phone

Our Inclusion Coordinator provided technical assistance to community child care providers and teachers through 354 phone conferences and conducted

- **149** on-site facility observations
- **110** program visits to observe specific children for development concerns
- **50** conferences to collaborate with other agencies
- 107 individual conferences with families



42 early learning programs voluntarily participate in our Quality Rating and Improvement System known as **Southwest Florida Stars**. 10 programs reached a 5-star rating.



Literacy Buddy Program: 1,362 children wrote letters to 914 adult buddies to tell them about their interests and received a total of 4,086 books.
