CEO Report- Susan Block	Ms. Block was unavailable to attend the meeting.	
Army Corps of Engineers- Brian Scott Older	 The Army Corps of Engineers is the #1 provider of water based recreation programs in the U.S., and their adopted "pet" program is water safety. Water safety programs are offered free (October through April) to any organization. Primary focus is schools. Last year (SY 2014-2015) programs were presented at 88 schools, reaching over 30,000 children.

ASQ's and Initial Interventions - Dick Parrish	 354 ASQ's were completed for the month of August for fiscal year 2015-2016. There were 177 ASQ's to be completed, 35 required ILP's and 2 were referred to the Inclusion Coordinator. 	
Inclusion Services – Lana Johnson	 Through the end of August for fiscal year 2015-2016, Lana Johnson had 15 referrals from ASQs and 1 from an outside agency for a total of 16 referrals. There were 3 referrals to Child Find and 2 referrals to FDLRS. 	
Vision and Hearing Screenings – Jill Corbett	 Hearing and Vision screenings have just begun for the 2015-1016 SY. No data is yet available. Hearing and Vision screenings by the ELC will no longer be done for VPK. Through a partnership with the Lion's Club of Bonita Springs and Ft. Myers, screenings will be offered to VPK programs. Dr. Freedman will coordinate the efforts. VPK programs will be contacted by the Lion's organization. Donna Thompson will continue to screen any VPK child for whom a teacher concern is expressed while she is at the facility. 	
Nursing Update Patricia Hansen	 Trainings have begun for the 2015-2016 school year. Twenty-six trainings are currently scheduled through December 2015. SIDS certification continues.
