Proposed Changes to Employee Reference Guide, Section 306	• Ms. Block returned with the proposed changes to Section 306. Ms. Puddefoot said that the Executive Committee did not have a problem with the increase in overall holiday. They asked the committee to reconsider the language to be more clearly stated. The committee worked on language that allows the CEO discretion on the use of the holiday to assure that the Coalition workflow is uninterrupted by staff holidays.
