220.1 Parental Choice for School Readiness Services and VPK Services

POLICY:

1. General:

- a. Parents applying for School Readiness (SR) or Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) services for their children shall be offered a full choice of child care settings and locations from eligible child care providers who have signed a SR/VPK Provider Agreement with the Coalition.
- b. Documentation supporting that the parent was provided a full choice of providers for the school readiness program will be determined by their signature on a Coalition approved form. The signed form must be filed in the parent/child file.

2. At-Risk Children

• Parents or caregivers of "At Risk" children, under the supervision of the Department of Children and Families, or their contracted providers, may <u>only</u> select from licensed child care programs or those owned and directly operated by the public school system, pursuant to Chapter 409.175 F.S. and Rule 65C-13 of the Florida Administrative Code.

3. Relative Care:

• For School Readiness services, parents may also choose a relative or "In home" care if they meet the requirements as an informal child care provider as addressed in Coalition Policy 408.2 "Informal Child Care Provider Policy".
