I was able to work side-by-side with Susan for several weeks before she left and am honored to have had the opportunity to learn from her depth of experience around early childhood education. Personally, I have been in the educational field for 20 years in a variety of capacities, from teaching 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade English to district-level administrative positions, most recently in an Associate Superintendent role. My area of expertise is in adult education and career and technical education. My focus over the past 10 years has been providing educational pathways to the parents of the children served by early childhood educators.

Strong relationships with stakeholders are critical to building effective programs and I believe that collaboration and communication are key to achieving the best outcomes for the children of our community. I plan to make stakeholder engagement a priority. To that end, in addition to visiting providers individually, I am planning regional Town Hall meetings to meet teachers, directors, and community members to learn your thoughts, ideas, and concerns.
