Florida VPK New School Year/ New Assessment Standards

Florida was one of the first states in the nation to offer free voluntary prekindergarten (VPK) to all 4-year-olds. Another enrollment year is upon us. This year, VPK students' progress will be assessed using a new tool - Florida's

Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST). The monitoring program is used to gauge student achievement in literacy and math.

PreK to K Easing the Transition



For children who are even in the

best childcare and VPK programs, the transition to a more structured Kindergarten setting can be difficult. To help smooth the way, the state of Florida has implemented a new program this year called **Transition to Kindergarten**.

The program aims to put preschool and kindergarten programs in communities across the state into a more cooperative approach to kindergarten expectations. Parents can also help by accessing the various **Toolkits** available on the Florida Division of early Learning website.

Preschool Pay

New Law Can Raise VPK Teacher Wages

House Bill 5001, which affects preschool Voluntary Prekindergarten Program (VPK) teacher pay, became effective on July 1, 2022. Providers who participate in the program can offer their VPK teachers a base rate of \$15.00 and hour for the 2022-2023 school year.
