She clarified that the purpose of the hearing was consider the ELC decision to recoup childcare payments and report to the Florida

Presentation by Early Learning Coalition Staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gilda Duran, Director of Risk Management reviewed the background of the Coalition's Decision to recoup funds for terminated childcare services. • Ms. Smith was required to sign a Rights and Responsibilities document upon enrollment in School Readiness in 2016. So, she was aware of her responsibilities to receive the funding. • Ms. Duran emphasized that reporting to the state is part of our required responsibilities to the state. 	
Presentation of Appeal by Lacey Glidden (Smith)	<p>Ms. Smith (she told us she does not go by Glidden) presented her appeal. The key points were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • She was advised by ELC staff that it was ok to exclude John Smith from the household income calculation. • She willing to pay back the amount owed to the ELC. 	
Conclusion of Appeal Hearing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Committee considered the documentation and presentations by both the ELC. Ms. Jefferson noted that Ms. Smith had an opportunity to address this issue when ELC staff requested documentation of John Smith's income and that she did not take that opportunity to respond. 	

<p>Committee Decision</p>	<p>The Committee agreed to support the ELC decision as is. They instituted this decision based on the following rationale. The Committee specifically stated these reasons in support of its decisions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ms. Smith had an opportunity to address this issue when ELC staff requested documentation of John Smith’s income and that she did not take that opportunity to respond. • The Coalition is mandated by our grant with the State of Florida to report recoupment amounts to the Department of Financial Services. 	<p>Motion to support the ELC decision to recoup childcare funds and report to the state Department of Financial Services.</p> <p>The ELC decision made by Jim Palmer.
