

- Once Summer VPK is over, reports will not be accessible.





VPK FAST Star Early Literacy 24-25

- School Year 24-25 VPK FAST Assessment
- All staff who are assessing children must complete the Renaissance-U <u>VPK FAST Star Early Literacy Test Administrators</u> course before their program begins VPK.
- There are 3 documents at the end that must be uploaded to the Provider Portal Document Library (2 Agreements and 1 Certificate of Completion).

VPK Instructional Hour

As used in the VPK program, the term "instructional hour" means:

1.Planned learning activities or experiences that implement curricula.

- Sixty consecutive or nonconsecutive minutes of instructional time in planned activities or experiences that implements a private provider's or public school's curricula for the VPK program.
- In accordance with s. 1002.67(2)(b), F.S., these planned activities or experiences must be developmentally appropriate and must:
- a. Be designed to prepare a student for early literacy and provide for instruction in early math skills;
- b. Enhance the age-appropriate progress of students in attaining the performance standards adopted by the
 Department of Education (see Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards 4 Years Old to Kindergarten (2017);
- c. Support student learning gains through differentiated instruction that shall be measured by the coordinated screening and progress monitoring program under s. 1008.25(8), F.S., and Rule 6M-8.620, F.A.C.

VPK Instructional Hour

2.Instructor is present and supervising.

• A credentialed instructor or substitute instructor, as defined in s. 1002.55(3)(c), F.S., and Rule 6M-8.410, F.A.C., must be present throughout the instructional time.

3.Instructor is engaged in activities or experiences, supervising children.

• The credentialed or substitute instructor must be actively engaged in the activities or experiences by teaching, guiding, interacting, supporting, or actively observing the activities or experiences.

Outside time during VPK hours is considered instructional and therefore may be assessed.
